### **Duties:**

Manages the perinatal psychosocial services and site Prenatal Plus Program.

- Manages/monitors the Mental Health Grant referrals to MHC's MD and on-site therapist.
- Ensures Mental Health Grant data collection as appropriate and required.
- Responsible for brief problem solving, cognitive therapy and self-management support for referred patients.
- Responsible for telephone call follow-up with caseload of pod referred high-risk chronic care patients, especially depression patients.
- Responsible for crisis intervention counseling as referred by providers.
- Functions as group visit team health education staff member as needed, including self-management with patients.
- Provides clinical supervision to the site case managers for prenatal high risk patients and psychosocial issues with chronic care patients.
- Acts as a consultant to other staff on skillful and effective intervention with patients, including crisis intervention.
- Serves as a resource to other staff regarding psychosocial issues and mental health diagnosis.
- Responsible for community agency outreach, networking and resource development.
- Assists with staff training as needed.
- Functions as chronic care self-management support expert and trainer at clinic sites.
- Assists with implementation of an effective Quality Improvement Program.
- Demonstrates knowledge of the principles of growth and development over the life span.

### **Qualifications:**

Master's Degree in Social Work, Marriage and Family Therapy or related master's degree and a license to practice in the State of Colorado or licensure required within six months of completion of supervision hours as required by the State Licensing Board requirements. Two years experience in community health preferred. Short term, strategic, goal oriented counseling skills in a CHC or other health care setting. Sensitivity to low income, ethnic minority community. Bilingual in Spanish required. Fun, progressive, work environment.
